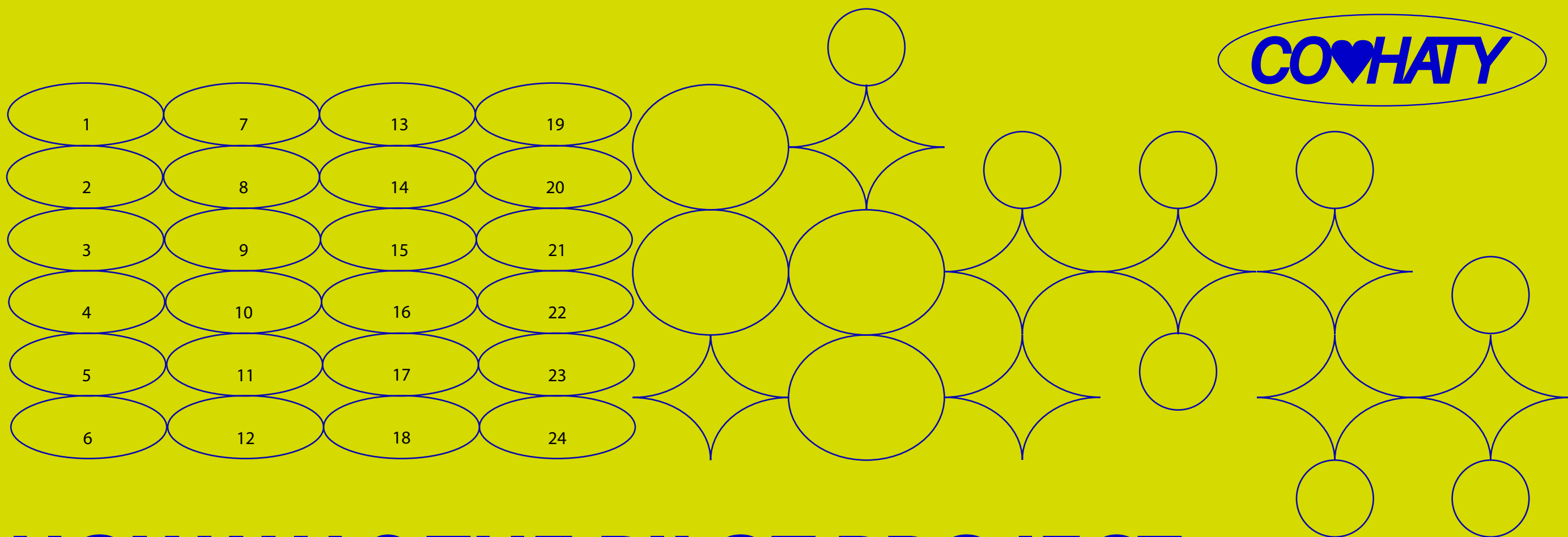

HOW WAS THE PILOT PROJECT COMPLETED?

We renovated **24 ROOMS** in the dormitory.

Also, we worked with common spaces – 4 kitchens and a dining room, a children's room, a hall, 8 bathrooms, showers and laundry, a cowworking space, and an entrance area.

We furnished and equipped these spaces. All the property was registered in the contract and conveyed to the state institution.

MOST OF THE RENOVATION WORKS WERE DONE DURING THE FIRST MONTH, SO THIS MONTH, WE COMPLETED THE DETAILS:

- installed new lamps in hallways and bathrooms;
- furnished a coworking space;
- painted window frames and railings of the stairs;
- installed air extractor in the showers;
- brought separate power cables to each floor;
- installed additional boilers;
- supplied home appliances, including washing machines;
- completed children's room;
- painted stairwells, basement, concierge booth, and entrance;
- finished construction of the wooden platform for the hall;
- and finally - cleaned it all.



ABOUT SETTLING

Seventeen families, a total of about 50 people, have already moved into the dormitory. The settlement is organized by the Ivano-Frankivsk regional state administration and Ivano-Frankivsk National Technical University of Oil and Gas.



WHAT'S NEXT?

We have already started with a new building - we are renovating a hotel. It has 5 floors, about 30 rooms, and a spacious dining room with regional decor.

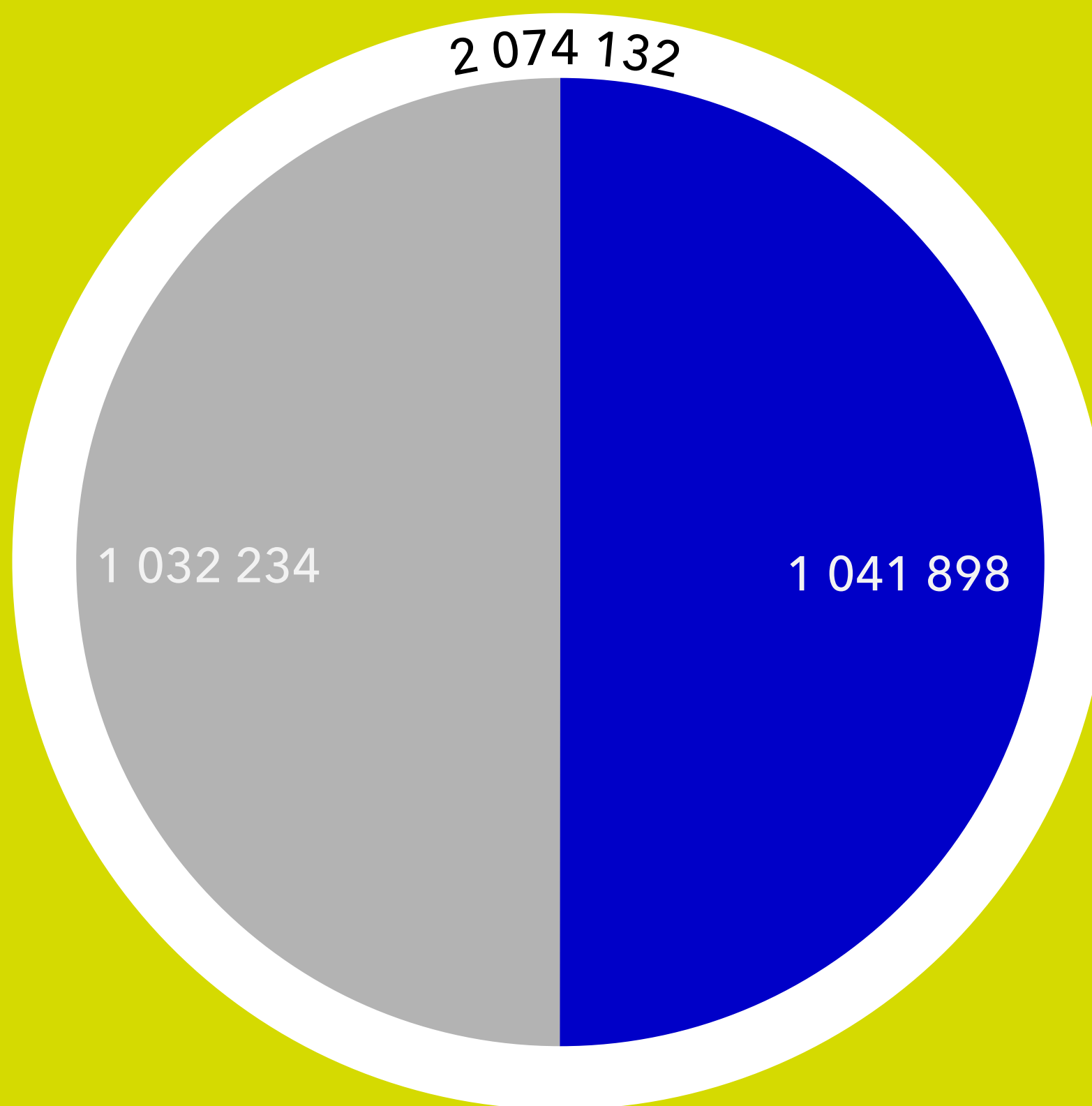
PARTNERS AND INSTITUTIONAL SUPPORT:
